## FOURTH ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Colleagues,

The programme of the conference has been announced in our website. This is almost the final one. Some minor changes are possible.

We have decided two parallel sessions on Friday afternoon and Saturday afternoon and we left free the Sunday because some of the participants are leaving on Sunday and also in order to give some same time to the participants during their stay in Athens. For your talk you can use a usb stick or transparencies. A blackboard is not available.

To go from the international airport to the centre of Athens you can take the metro (but not the "proasteiakos" which is in a parallel line) or the bus X95 which is very close to the exit of the arrival's building and is working for 24 hours. (See in our website).

The place of the conference is the Conference Room of the Administration building (Ktirio Diikisis) of the National Technical University of Athens (Polytechneio), in Zografou Campus (Polytechnioupoli Zografou). To reach the place of the conference from the hotel you can take the metro, stop in Katechaki station and take the Bus 242 (see in our website). By a taxi the cost is about 7 euro.

For your convenience, a bus of the conference will pick up our participants from Ilisia Hotel on Friday at 8:15 and from President Hotel at 8:40. On Saturday a bus will start form Ilisia Hotel at 8:25 and from President Hotel at 8:40. The bus will drive also our participants back to the hotel in the afternoon.

At Saturday night (8:00-11:00) we will have a dinner and also a 45' walk in the old part of Athens, around Acropolis, if the weather is suitable.

We are also ready to organize a guided tour on Sunday to the Archaiological Museum, to Acropolis and to cape Sounion (temple of Poseidon). Unfortunately we cannot finance this excursion. The participants who are leaving on Sunday afternoon can follow the first part, i.e. Archaiological Museum and Acropolis.
